Rank Advancements:

(On Sunday morning, we’ll be dedicating time to the following Tenderfoot, 2nd Class & 1st Class Rank Advancement Requirements. Our older scouts and Assistant Scoutmasters will be teaching/training the younger scouts on the following rank requirements:

- TENDERFOOT: 4a (whip & fuse the ends of a rope (page 34), and 4b (knots – two half hitches & the taut-line hitch (pages 38-41)
- SECOND CLASS: 2c (proper care and use of knife, saw and ax (pages 77-85)
- FIRST CLASS: 4d (safe handling & storage of food for campouts (pages 258, 263, 281)

Scoutmaster Conferences:

- Time will be dedicated on Sunday morning for Scoutmaster Conferences for all ranks except Eagle (scout handbook required).
