Boy Scouts of America requires that *“All vehicles MUST be covered by a public liability and property damage liability insurance policy. The amount of this coverage must meet or exceed the insurance requirement of the state where the vehicle is licensed (In Virginia these limits are set at \$25,000 / \$50,000 Bodily Injury and \$20,000 Physical Damage). It is recommended, however, that coverage limits are at least \$50,000 / \$100,000 / \$50,000 or \$100,000 combined single limit.”*
