







The Conference has many worship restrictions in place. How likely are you to return to in-person worship with those restrictions in place?


How are you connecting to worship?


Do you worship "live" at 11 AM or later in the week?


What has been your experience of the online worship?



When in-person worship resumes, how important is it to you that we maintain a quality online worship experience?

When in-person worship resumes, which best describes your attitude toward returning to an in-person worship service?




In addition to guidance/timelines of the governor and UMC, are there other signals you would want to see before you return to attend an in-person worship service?




As we prepare to gather again in person, we want to know how you feel about smaller non worship-related gatherings.




In regards to in-person gatherings of kids/students, what is your comfort level at this time?




How have you connected with Trinity in the weeks since March 15?
