**Communion** this evening is being served by the ancient practice of intinction.

Please come down the center aisle to receive a piece of bread, and dip it into the cup before partaking and return to your seat via a side aisle.

You are welcome to use the chancel rail for personal prayer after receiving the elements.

The United Methodist Church practices open communion, meaning that *anyone* who desires a relationship with Christ is welcome at the table.

The cup contains unfermented grape juice, in response to the United Methodist position of alcohol abstinence.
